## Sports Premium 2015/16

In March 2013, the Government launched its PE and Sport funding. This funding is focused to achieve the following results:

- Preserve the Olympic and Paralympic legacy while developing school sport; and
- Develop an enjoyment of sport and physical activity, while promoting a healthy lifestyle in children from an early age.

Our primary school received funding as follows in the 2015/16 academic year:

We received funding for 2014/15 later than expected as we are a new school, so this delayed some of our spending.

At St Richard Reynolds Catholic Primary School we have spent the money on or have plans in place to spend the money on the following:

### Teaching resources for PE lessons:

- Gymnastics: Mats, benches, pommel horse
- Rugby: Tags, rugby balls
- Dance: Scheme of work
- Athletics: Use of our local track for lessons and Sports Day, indoor athletics equipment

### Staff training:

- Trampolining & Athletics course

### Buying back into the Richmond School Sports Partnership:

This means we get to enter the local competitions and festivals; our Yr2 & Yr1 gymnastic team recently entered into the festival of gymnastics at St. James' school.

### Specialist Coaching:

- Taster sessions for soft archery & fencing
- Extension of after school club provisions

The impact that this additional funding has had is to increase opportunities for our children and to encourage our children to adopt and develop healthy lifestyles. All of our primary school children have benefitted from the additional provision, regardless of sporting ability.

Going forward, we plan to put in place means of measuring the impact of the additional spending more formally and to link it to other ongoing school initiatives, such as the Healthy Schools programme.
