PROVIDING OF INFORMATION TO PROVIDERS OF YOUTH SUPPORT SERVICES AND THE RIGHT TO OPT OUT

Once your child is aged 13 or over, we are required by law to pass on certain information to providers of youth support services in your area. This is the local authority support service for young people aged 13 to 19 in England. We must provide both the child's and parent's name(s) and address, and any further information relevant to the support services' role.

However, if the child is over 16, the child (or the parent(s)) can ask that no information beyond names, address and your date of birth be passed to the support service. The School will not give information about you to anyone outside of the school without your consent unless the law and rules allow us to. The School is required by law to pass some information about you to the Local Authority and the Department for Education (DfE).
