A new Chess year starts on **12th September 2024**. It is open to **Y7-Y10 only** of any standard, including complete beginners. With **limited places** available they will be offered to pupils in these age groups on a **first-come-first-served** basis.

We play and learn about strategy and tactics together

Chess **improves concentration, memory and calculating ability, develops cognitive thinking** and analytical skills, training the mind to **plan ahead**.

Although fun, it is not all about winning. They will learn from their losses and become more **resilient**, and learn to stay **calm under pressure**. You will see your child grow in confidence as they progress! Several **Gigafinalists** produced last year.

This Autumn Term all children will be prepared for the popular UK Chess Challenge (70,000 kids nationwide take part!) which starts in the Spring Term. In addition, some children will be entered for the ECF Certificate of Excellence – Bronze/Silver/Gold levels

Our names are Colin Aniecko and Derek McGovern and we are taking over the Club from Mark and Hilary Hogarth who passed it onto us. They have taught chess at the school over several years, building up a thriving, competitive and friendly environment and will be sadly missed. We wish them well.

Both of us are very experienced teachers and players spanning several years, having successfully played at Club, County and national level (4NCL). Complete beginners are **taught from scratch** until they are ready to be assimilated into the main group which covers openings/middlegame strategy/basic endgames & checkmating patterns as well as tournament preparation and play.
