St Richard Reynolds Catholic College has a strict uniform policy which forms part of the Home School Agreement. Our policy is intended to:

- Develop a strong sense of belonging to the St Richard Reynolds community
- Encourage students to take pride in their appearance and in their role as ambassadors for the College
- Educate students in the need to dress appropriately for different purposes

Uniform is expected to be worn correctly at all times, including the journey to and from the College. Thank you for referring to this Policy when purchasing shoes or clothing. If you are in any doubt about what is acceptable, please ask one of the College's Leadership Team.

Students are not allowed to wear non-uniform items even if they have just been bought; and these non-uniform items may well be confiscated as a result.

Students who do not meet our expectations for uniform, including hairstyle, will not be allowed to represent the College on trips or on sporting teams. Offending students may be sent home to correct their uniform, if necessary, or may be supplied with a replacement item to wear.

The College has a limited supply of second-hand uniform available for resale. Further information about uniform sales will be provided by the College.

School Days are the current official uniform supplier as appointed by the Governing Body, but as indicated in the policy it is possible to purchase some items from high street or online stores, provided that the item complies with the descriptions set out in this policy. **School Days** are located at 94 High Street, Whitton, Twickenham, Middlesex, TW2 7LN (020 8898 4881). Socks	Grey or black socks where trousers or shorts are worn, grey, black or white socks where skirts are worn. No logos.		
Tights	Grey, black or flesh coloured. <i>(No socks over tights to be worn)</i>		
Shoes	Should be black and able to take polish. No heels, boots or trainers.

Coat	Plain, with no visible branding . No hoodies unless it is the College hoodie when worn as part of the sports kit.

Leggings / Skins	Plain black leggings or skins that can be worn under skorts or shorts.		
Trainers*	Running or sport trainers are necessary. Students will be told when to bring in studs or gum shields for specific sports.		

General	
Jewellery	Students may wear: • One pair of small stud earrings in silver or gold to be worn in the lower lobes • A plain wristwatch • A plain cross or crucifix worn under a shirt All items are worn at the student's own risk.
Make up	None allowed.
Nails	No nail polish, acrylic nails or long nails that inhibit active involvement in learning.
Hair	Conventional hair styles; unnatural hair colours and shaved patterns are not acceptable. Hair bands and clips should be simple and in school colours: black, red or grey. Long hair should be tied back for Sport, Science and Food Technology.

Any uniform that is tapered/altered in any way will result in a uniform infringement detention. Families will be required to purchase new uniform items that are not altered and in the interim students could be asked to wear school supplied uniforms so that they adhere to our uniform policy. For example, if a skirt has been altered, a student may be required to wear school supplied skirt or trousers for a period of time until a new or second-hand uniform item has been purchased.
